

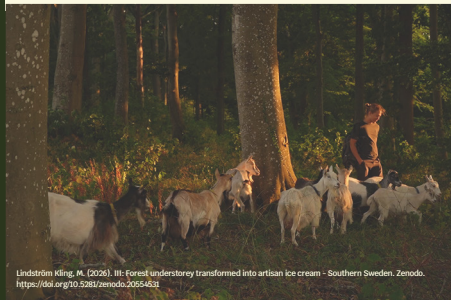
Agroforestry for healthier animals and more resilient farms
